

#### 2024 AACOG REGIONAL AWARDS

Since 1974, the AACOG Regional Awards program has recognized individuals, organizations, and projects across the region for their dedication and work to enhance the quality of life of Alamo Area residents. The Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) is accepting nominations for the 2022 AACOG Regional Awards. Award recipients will be honored during the AACOG Area Council and Board of Directors Annual Luncheon on Wednesday, December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Any person, corporation, community project, or government project that has contributed to the positive advancement of the communities inside the Alamo Area (Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, McMullen, Medina, and Wilson counties) is eligible for nomination.

\*Previous award recipients are ineligible for the same category if they have won within the past three years. Current elected officials are also ineligible for nomination unless directly involved in a project.

- Complete entire nomination form (or online form) for each entry. Please complete separate nomination form for each individual, project, or organization.

#### **NOMINATION CATEGORIES**

## Regional Citizen of the Year

Honoring individuals who demonstrate a dedication to the community through activities and volunteerism outside the scope of their employment. Current elected officials are ineligible for nomination

## Corporate / Business Steward of the Year

Honoring small, medium, and large for-profit companies that make a positive impact on their local communities through activities such as employee volunteering initiatives, fundraising activities, and other efforts that have established the corporation as a community partner and leader

## Community / Non-Profit Project of the Year

Honoring community-based or non-profit projects that have made a positive impact to the communities involved in or affected by the project. Projects not yet completed are ineligible

### **Government / Municipal Project of the Year**

Honoring governmental entity-based projects that have significantly impacted the community and its residents. Projects not yet completed are ineligible

#### **Lifetime Achievement Award**

Honoring individuals that have significantly contributed to the betterment of the AACOG region over their career or lifetime. This recognition may not be awarded every year.

\*Individuals nominated under this category may, at the discretion of the AACOG Community Affairs Committee, instead be recognized under the Regional Citizen of the Year category

### Mission Partner of the Year Award

Honoring organizations AACOG has collaborated with the past year who truly mirror the agency's values, and contribute to the mission of enhancing the quality of life of Alamo Area residents.

## Rising Star Award

Honoring youth ages 14 to 18 who inspire and demonstrate a dedication to service outside of standard academic work.



#### **SCORING CRITERIA**

## **Project Description | 30 Points**

Overall summary of the individual, project, or effort, incorporating who, what, where, when, and why this nomination deserves recognition

# Impact on the Community | 20 Points

Explain how this project enhances the quality of life for residents of the respective community and/or the greater Alamo Area

## **Measurable Achievements | 30 Points**

Provide quantitative data reflecting the success of the individual's or program's efforts. Describe how many individuals were positively impacted, reached, etc.

## Partnerships Developed | 20 Points

Describe any collaboration with community organizations, governmental agencies, churches, or other organized groups that aided to the success of this individual's or project's efforts
